Love Like Jesus

John 13:34-35

“A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this, everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.”

As we enter a month that celebrates love, let us be reminded of the command given to us by our Savior and Lord, and that is to love one another, as He has loved us.

As He has loved us...so we are to love one another.

Jesus teaches a parable that speaks to this love He calls us to give. In this parable, Jesus shares how a Jewish man who had been robbed and beaten, was laying on the road near death. Jesus revealed how a priest and Levite (someone who served in the Temple of God) each at different times, saw this injured man lying on the road, ignored him and passed by. They both let him suffer. Then a Samaritan man saw the injured Jew and was moved with compassion for him. He picked him up, cleaned and bound up his wounds and took him to rest at an inn nearby, paying for the costs while the man recovered. Samaritan people as a whole were people the Jews would not associate with for they were considered impure.

Jesus asked those listening, “which of these do you think proved to be a neighbor?” They answered, “the Samaritan.” Jesus said, “Go, and do likewise.” For He earlier said in that parable love your neighbor as yourself.

It is the Samaritan who loved like Jesus loves us. His love put into action for this broken man was sacrificial in pride, time, and resources. He laid it all down to show love for this person in his time of need. His active love came without conditions. He didn’t require the man to pay him back; he freely gave in the moment as he was able to. He was forgiving in his heart and set aside cultural differences, even hatred between their groups, and chose to see a human being, not the enemy.

This may seem to be too much in some circumstances you are facing or in our culture right now, but we must remember we were never asked to do this in our own ability. We ARE able to love others as Christ loves us because we have the love of God in us. We have the strength of Christ in us to draw from. Let us also remember God would never ask us to do something He wasn’t willing to do first for us. He demonstrated the most sacrificial love we’ll ever know by sending His Son to die on the cross in our place. Our sin was atoned for so we could forever enjoy a love relationship with our God.

Remember the Good Samaritan. Remember Jesus, and love others as He has loved you.

One act of sacrificial and generous love at a time becomes a ripple effect in the world.
